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**BuzzTaxi sends Ripper to Oz**

Canadian factual distributor BuzzTaxi has secured an Australian deal for a documentary on Jack the Ripper amidst a host of pre-Mipcom sales and acquisitions.

The Real Jack the Ripper (1x60') from MDF Productions has been sold to Foxtel in Australia along with 8x60' series Betrayal! from Associated Producers.

A deal has also been secured for 26 episodes of The Decorating Adventures of Ambrose Price with Canal+ in Poland. The Firvalley Productions series originally aired on HGTV in Canada and follows the interior designer through a series of challenges.

All 26 episodes of another Firvalley production, HGTV's Top Ten, have been picked up by Ananey in Israel while natural history one-off Uakari: Secrets of the English Monkey has been picked up by French broadcaster TF1.

The programmes form part of BuzzTaxi's slate for Mipcom which also includes a host of newly acquired male skewing series.

AppTV (13x30') is described as a fast paced ride through the world of mobile phone apps that helps viewers get the most from their devices, while GetConnected (26x30') also aims to increase understanding of technology. Both have been picked up from Canadian prodco Blink Media Works.

BuzzTaxi is also distributing Discovery Channel 9x60' series Beyond Survival, hosted by Survivorman's Les Stroud.
